

Health Checkup

In accordance with Japanese law, schools in Japan are obligated to conduct health checkup on all students. If you miss the school health checkup, you must go to a hospital to pay for your own health checkup and provide the result to the school's healthcare center. Moreover, school will not be able to provide you with a health checkup certificate often necessary to apply for higher education. We urge you to take the health checkup conducted by our school.

Schedule and meeting place: Find out your meeting day, date, time and place.

Venue : 4th floor of A-Building (A044ab, A045ab, A mobile medical vehicle in front of Plaza)

Who: All students (except for the short-term Japanese Language Course students)

Health checkup includes:

- ① Height / Weight (A044b) : For nutritional and other evaluation
- ② Physical exams by a medical doctor (A045a) :
Overall health evaluation, including listening to your heart and lungs using stethoscope*
*Note that the doctor will place the stethoscope against your chest and back
Be prepared to give Japanese name/s of illness/es in the past and present if any
- ③ Chest X-ray (A mobile medical vehicle in front of Plaza) : For early detection of Tuberculosis
Early detection is important since TB can be cured
※If you are pregnant or possibly pregnant, please notify Healthcare Center staff before the checkup because you cannot take the chest X-ray examination.

Things you must prepare and bring:

- 1) Must wear (or bring and wear) a plain T-shirt (see ③ below. It's very important)
- 2) Must tie up your hair with a hair rubber band if your hair is as long as to your shoulders
- 3) We recommend you to wear a mask at the health checkup venue

Important:

- ① If you are feeling sick, you cannot take the health checkup on that day.
- ② Since the doctor uses stethoscope for examination, school recommends you to wear a large size T-shirt. You must avoid dress or jumpsuit. While waiting your turn, refrain from talking to prevent disturbing the stethoscope examination.
- ③ For chest X-ray, you must wear a plain T-shirt, meaning NO studs, buttons, zippers, designs, prints, decorations, embroideries, whatsoever **in front nor back**. Prepare in advance.
- ④ At the venue or in the hallway, refrain from talking.
- ⑤ Make sure you look after your valuables. Other things, if you like, you may leave them in your classroom.

Result of the health checkup:

The report of the health checkup in a sealed envelope will be handed to you after about a month. Depending on the result, students may be asked by the healthcare center to visit them again. Those students must go to the healthcare center on the appointed time.
