

Guidance on joining Bunka Gakuen University student clubs

Bunka Institute of language students can join BGU's student clubs.

Students interested in joining clubs should fill out the "Entry Form" on the back and submit it to the Admissions Office.

Important notes for joining clubs include the following:

- **Club activities start at 5:00 PM at the earliest. However, if the activity venue is unavailable due to classes or other commitments, the start time may be delayed to 6:50 PM.**
- Japanese is used for communication within the clubs. Please consider your Japanese proficiency level before participating.
- Depending on the club, you may not be able to join if you do not meet the membership requirements.
- Some clubs charge membership fees, while others do not. Activity schedules—including the days and times—vary by club. Some clubs also hold activities during long breaks, such as summer or winter vacation. Please prioritize your classes and personal studies, and participate in a way that is manageable for you.
- If BIL determines that club activities are negatively affecting a student's health, attendance record, academic performance, or attitude toward studies, it may suspend or discontinue their participation in the club.

Please also refer to the "List of Eligible Clubs" on the back when selecting clubs.

Details regarding items ① through ④ on the "List of Eligible Clubs" are as follows.

- ① Inexperienced • • Welcome inexperienced student who has motivation.
- ② Individual activity • • • Activities are often carried out individually (such as creating works). This program is not suitable for students who wish to engage in activities while interacting with Japanese students.
- ③ Emphasis on interaction • • • The gathering emphasizes the members' interaction and enjoyment together. This club is ideal for students who wish to interact with Japanese students in a friendly, welcoming atmosphere.
- ④ Year round acceptance • • • Usually clubs accept new member in April only, but it is possible to join from May onwards as well.
